Volleyball team loses at Fresno

It may seem like a small consolation, but the Concordia women's volleyball team won a game at Fresno Pacific.

The Eagles lost in four games, but it marked the first time since 1998 that Concordia has gone to a fourth game at Fresno Pacific, as the NAIA's top ranked and defending champion.

Fourth-ranked Concordia had its record fall to 12-2 overall and 4-2 in Golden State Athletic Conference play.

Fresno Pacific improved to 14-0 and 6-0 in conference and extended its winning streak to 55 with the 25-23, 25-17, 22-25, 25-16 victory.

Concordia was led by 18 kills by NAIA All-American senior opposite Amber Riddens, who also had three aaces in the loss.

Sophomore Brooke Marino led the Eagles with 14 digs, while senior setter Renee Horton dealt out 35 assists.




